Proving that comfort requires no compromise, Terracotta Village by Heathwood Homes makes fresh living look easy.

Located near Mavis Road and the 407, Terracotta sets the bar for comfort high with spacious, well-appointed townhomes sprouting around a large park area complete with pond and walking trails.

Heathwood Homes president Hugh Heron says the design goal of the finished homes is to achieve a blending of modern good looks with classic comfort.

"It's current and it's comfy and homey at the same time. There's a whole lifestyle projected here," Heron said.

Inside, the open-concept layout gels perfectly with modern family life and features visual accents in details like crown moulding, granite countertops and wood flooring.

A living room decked

out in cream shades, silver and glass makes the most of natural warmth projected by the dark wood flooring and subtle furniture choices contribute to the inviting nature of the room.

The kitchen reveals what that comfort and style can

can be done with a classic look contrasting eggshell whites with floral red shades and more traditional, French-styled chairs. Dark granite countertops contrast neatly with slick white cabinetry, proving have a happy union.

"The decoration shows what can be achieved. It's a combination of being wide-open and comfy. We want people to go through and feel they're home at last," Heron said.

Smart external visual features on Terracotta homes include steeply pitched gables, columned covered porches, brick and stone exteriors and expansive windows.
